Recognition was accorded for classes VIII (E.M) for the academic year 2021-22, in respect of Academic Heights School, Moosarambagh, Saidabad(v), Saidabad(m), Hyderabad(dist).

The Correspondent of Academic Heights School, Moosarambagh, Saidabad(v), Saidabad(m), Hyderabad(dist) has submitted the proposals for grant of Renewal Recognition of classes VIII (E.M) (with one section) from the year 2021-22 to 2030-31.

The Deputy Education Officer, Saidabad, Hyderabad has verified the proposals with reference to the conditions laid down in the Recognition orders and GO Ms No 1/Edn, Dated: 01-01-1994 and subsequent Government Orders submitted a detailed report through the letter

After careful examination of the proposals of the Correspondent and report of the Deputy Education Officer, Saidabad, Hyderabad based on the recommendation of the District Education Officer, Hyderabad, the Regional Joint Director of School Education, Hyderabad is pleased to accord the Renewal Recognition of Classes VIII (E.M) (with one section) for a period of ten (10) years from 2021-22 to 2030-31 in respect of Academic Heights School, Moosarambagh, Saidabad(v), Saidabad(m), Hyderabad(dist). The management is requested to follow the conditions.

1. The above Renewal Recognition is accorded purely on a temporary basis and is subjected to the reports of State Level Inspection and Vigilance Committee fulfilling of all the pre requisite condition under the A.P Education Act 1982 and if later found that the school has not fulfilled any pre requisites as stipulated, the Renewal Recognition now being given is liable to be withdrawn at any time.

2. That the society shall abide to the rules and regulations made in the Govt. Orders cited and subsequent orders.

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3. That the Society shall provide the necessary amenities like accommodation sanitary facilities, drinking water facilities, furniture, Library, Laboratory, equipment play field required staff as per the staff pattern another facilities.
4. That the Renewal Recognition is accorded to the SRI R D GARG EDUCATION SOCIETY.
5. The Renewal Recognition is accorded to run the school in the locality and there shall not be any change in the premises of locality specified in the orders.
6. The management should follow the G.O.Ms.No.22 ,dated 18-07-2017 i.e ., the weight of the school bag not to exceed 4kg for VI-VII,4.5 kg for VIII-IX and 5 kg for X.
7. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September
8. The Management has to follow the government norms from time to time, for collection of fee from students.
9. That educational agency shall not use the premises building, play ground and vacant site belongs to the institution for any purpose other than the Educational activities and conducting authorized examinations without permission of DEO.
10. The management should follow the guidelines issued in G.O.Ms. No. 36., School Education (General) Dept., Dt:- 16-12-2017 for the safety and security of the children in the schools.
11. The management should pay the mandate taxes due to the concerned departments as per schedule fixed by the Government.
12. The school shall follow the traffic and safety guidelines indicated by the police and fire services departments
13. The school shall have 'first aid-kit' and the teachers shall be trained in first aid.
14. That any children studied in recognized school of other states/countries affiliated to the bodies recognized by the state or central government shall not be admitted without prior permission of the District Educational Officer/Director of School Education.
15. That the management shall not collect any fees or donations either in cash or kind other than the fees prescribed by the governing body from pupils or parents or any other person or on their behalf for any purpose.
16. That educational agency shall not force any member of the staff or students of the institutions to take part in the religious discourses and preaching of religion irrespective of whether they belong to the same belief or not.
17. If the Management provides transportation, it is the responsibility of the Management to submit Fitness Certificates of their buses every year regularly to the D.E.O. to have skilled, Trained, Licensed and healthy driver. If any deviation in this matter, they will be personally held responsible.
18. The Correspondent should submit Renewal of Recognition proposal before the expiry of Renewal Recognition.



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19. The Educational Agency should Implement the Guidelines for Safe and Effective use of Internet & Digital Technologies in schools and school buses issued by CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-32/2017, dated 18.08.2017 communicated by MHRD, Govt. of India.

20. The Educational Agency should Implement the Model Education Code prepared by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015

21. That educational agency shall not permit the students of any D.Ed/B.Ed colleges or college of physical education or any teacher training institution to have teaching practice without the permission of the District Educational Officer.

22. Proper and adequate parking area for vehicles shall be provided transporting the children to and from the school.

23. Proper and adequate safety measures shall be taken for children within the school campus and also near the school premises.

24. The Parent Teachers Associations meeting shall be conducted to sensitize the parents on the safety of the children

25. The school shall constitute Committees for redressal of the Public/ Staff/ Parents/ Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Committees under POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act, 2012 and details of these Committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on School Notice Board and conspicuously on the School Website for the information of all the stakeholders.

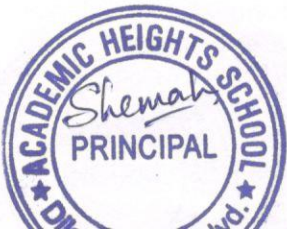

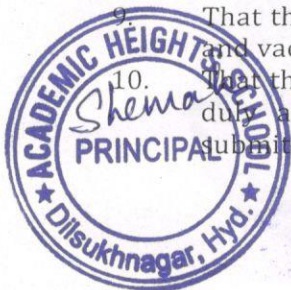

Moosarambagh Dilsukhnagar, Hyderabad District, has submitted the proposal through the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Saidabad Mandal-II, for granting of **Extension of Temporary recognition (ETR) for Classes Pre - Primary to VII (E/M)** for the year **2020-2021 to 2029 - 2030**, in the references 5th cited.


After careful examination of the references read above and interms of G.O.Ms.no.1 Edn. Dt.01-1-1994 read with G.O. Ms. No. 52 Edn. Dt. 28-2-98, G.O.Ms.No. 23 Dt.10-3-99, G.O.Ms.No.41, Dt.11-05-2006, G.O.Ms.No.74, Dt.02-07-2006 and G.O.Ms.No.58, Dt.13-07-2006 and G.O.Ms.No.88, Dt.07-07-2008 and as per the report submitted by the Deputy Inspector of Schools, Saidabad Mandal-II, in the reference 5th cited, the competent authority has accorded **Extension of Temporary recognition (ETR) for Classes Pre - Primary to VII (E/M) from the year 2020-2021 to 2029-2030**, in respect of the Academic Heights School, H.No:16-11-477/6/3/A. Moosarambagh Dilsukhnagar, Saidabad Mandal-II, Hyderabad District, Subject to the condition that the management shall fulfill the following conditions.

1. That Class rooms with an area of not less than 240 Sq.feet at the rate of one for each section in case of Upper Primary and Secondary sections at the rate of one for every 40 students in case of primary sections shall be provided.
2. That adequate accommodation for the staff, Library and Laboratories shall be provided.
3. That adequate sanitary facilities and water including drinking water shall be provided.
4. That adequate furniture, Library books, Lab equipment and play material shall be provided.
5. That sufficient number of qualified staff shall be appointed.
6. That the educational agencies shall prescribe the scales of pay to the teaching and non-teaching staff.
7. That the educational institutions shall serve the needs of the locality.
8. That the Educational Institutions shall adopt the curriculum, syllabus, text books and work books prescribed by the government.
9. That the Educational Institutions shall follow the school timings mid-term holidays and vacation as prescribed by the government.
10. That the administrative report and the audited statement of accounts of the school duly attested by the Chartered accountant for every financial year shall be submitted to the District Educational Officer, latest by September.



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- c) Ensure that supporting staff is employed only from authorized agencies and proper records are maintained.
- d) To constitute a Parent-Teacher-Students Committee to address the safety needs of the students and to take regular feedback from the Parents in this regard.
- e) The access to the school building by outsiders should be controlled and visitors monitored Maintain Visitors register for every entry and exit of all persons / staff / parents.
- f) To provide training to the staff so that they discharge their responsibilities properly and promptly to protect children from any form of abuse.
- g) The school shall constitute Committees for redressal of the Public/ Staff/Parents/ Students grievances, Internal Complaints Committee on Sexual Harassment and Committees under POCSO (Protection of Children from Sexual Offence) Act, 2012 and details of these Committees along with contact details shall be displayed prominently on School Notice Board and conspicuously on the School Website for the information of all the stakeholders.
- h) To engage lady conductors and provide separate toilets for drivers and the house keeping team etc.
- i) Presence of a female attendant to be ensured for nursery to Pre-Primary sections outside the wash rooms/toilets/changing rooms in all the schools.
- j) The children travelling by school bus should be the responsibility of the school from the time they board the school bus till they are handed over to their parents.
- k) That a person employed with the schools, if found guilty/charged of any criminal offence / antecedents, besides Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act (POCSO) and Juvenile Justice Act, should be immediately terminated.
- The Educational Agency should implement the Model Education Code prepared by National University for Educational Planning and Administration in 2015.
- The Educational Agency should implement comprehensive set of Guidelines on the Safety and Security of Children issued by the Ministry of Human Resource and Development (MHRD), Govt. of India communicated vide D.O.Lr.No.10-11/2014-EE-4 of Addl. Secretary (SE) dt.09.10.2014.
- The Educational Agency should implement the Guidelines for Safe and Effective use of Internet & Digital Technologies in schools and school buses issued by CBSE vide Circular No.Acad-32/2017, dated 18.08.2017 communicated by MHRD, Govt. of India.
